



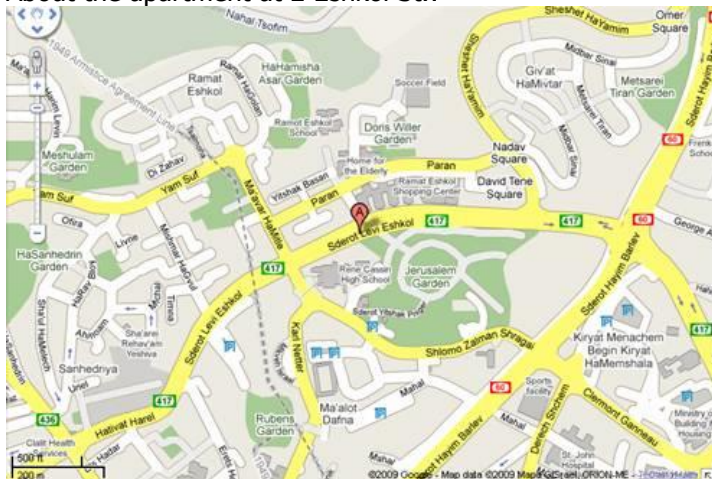
# YOUR APARTMENT

## *Professional Information for Dental Volunteers*

Thank you for volunteering to help the underprivileged children of Jerusalem. As you will see while working in the clinic, your services are greatly needed.

About the apartment at 2 Eshkol St.:



### Address

2 Sderot Eshkol, Apt. No. 53, Ground floor – the first apartment on the right

**The entrance to the building is around the back – on Midbar Sinai St.!!!!**

It is the 3rd (last) entrance to the building from the parking lot off Midbar Sinai Street, Jerusalem

### Description

3 room apartment – 2 bedrooms, living room with sofa bed, kitchen and dining area  
Suitable for a couple and up to 3 children

Please note: DVI rents this apartment to host our volunteers from abroad and we are accountable by our landlord for any damage. DVI does not have a large maintenance staff and we therefore ask you to care for the apartment as you would your own home.

- Please do not move the furniture
- Please take care of all appliances in the apartment
- Do not leave the electric water heater on for more than 2-3 hours a day

**All apartments are available from Friday at 12 noon to the following Friday until 9:30 A.M.** since our cleaning lady will arrive then to clean the apartment for the next dentist. If you need to leave your luggage for a few hours, you may leave it by the door, but this must be arranged in advance with our office staff. Linens and towels are provided in the apartment, and there are basic kitchen supplies in the functional kitchen.

**ON THE DAY OF YOUR DEPARTURE:** We ask you to ensure the sofa bed is closed and leave everything as it was at your arrival, including clean dishes and other utensils you used during your stay. Before leaving, please make sure all windows and shades are closed. Lock the front door and take the key with you to return to your representative.

## Driving directions to 2 Eshkol St, Jerusalem, Israel

1. Upon leaving the airport
  2. Keep right at the fork and merge onto **Route 1** 44.7 km
  3. Take exit **Golda Meir Boulevard- שדרות גולדה מאיר** toward **Sderot Golda Me'ir/ שדרות גולדה מאיר** 350 m
  4. Take exit **Har Hotsvim- הר הוצבים** to merge onto **Sderot Golda Me'ir/ שדרות גולדה מאיר** 2.6 km
  5. Continue onto **Shmu'el HaNavi/ שמואל הנביא** 160 m
  6. Turn left onto **Bar Ilan/ בר אילן** 10 m
  7. Continue onto **Hativat Harel/ חטיבת הראל** 300 m
  8. Continue onto **Sderot Levi Eshkol/ שדרות לוי אשכול** 900 m
  9. Turn left onto **Sheshet HaYamim/ ששת הימים** 170 m
  10. At the roundabout, take the **1st** exit onto **Midbar Sinai/ מדבר סיני** 300 m

Estimated driving time: 43 minutes

## Getting to the Clinic

On your first day of work at the clinic you will be picked up at approx. 7:30 a.m. and taken to the clinic by a DVI staff member or volunteer. Please wait in front of the apartment building. The rest of the week, you will need to make your own way:

### Bus Lines to the Clinic: The 77 and 77κ

Pick up the bus on Midbar Sinai St., near the corner of Sheshet Hayamim St.

Get off the bus at the last Emek Refaim St. stop (approx. a 30 minute ride)

Continue walking straight on Emek Refaim until a traffic light – the corner of General Pierre Koenig

Turn left on General Pierre Koenig

Immediately after the gas station (one block), make a right onto Mekor Chaim St.

The Clinic's address: 29 Mekor Chaim (on the left side)

Total travel time: approx. 40 minutes

### Light Rail

The train runs from Haim Bar Lev St. (next to the Ramat Eshkol apartment) into the center of town.

From the Strauss/Jaffa St. train stop, you can switch for a 21 bus. Get off on the first stop on General

Pierre Koenig St. – you will see a gas station on your right. Turn right at the gas station onto Mekor

Chaim St. – the clinic is at 29 Mekor Chaim, on the left side.

### Driving directions

1. Turn left out of parking lot onto Midbar Sinai St
  2. At the roundabout, turn left into Sheshet HaYamim St
  3. Turn left onto Sderot Levi Eshkol
  4. Turn right at Sderot Hayim Barlev
  5. Continue on Heil HaHandasa
  6. Slight left to stay on Heil HaHandasa
  7. Continue on HaTsanhanim (there is a tunnel)
  8. Continue on Shlomo HaMelech
  9. Continue on David HaMelech
- Keep left at the fork!
10. Turn right on Derech Beit Lehem
  11. Turn right at Emek Refaim
  12. Turn left at General Pierre Koenig
  13. Turn right at Mekor Haim (at the gas station)
  14. Arrive at clinic, 29 Mekor Haim St, on left

Total Distance: 5.5 km – about 15 min (in average morning traffic, more like 30 min)

From Levi Eshkol St.:

Turn on to Sheshet Hayamim St.

Turn right at the traffic circle onto Midbar Sinai St.

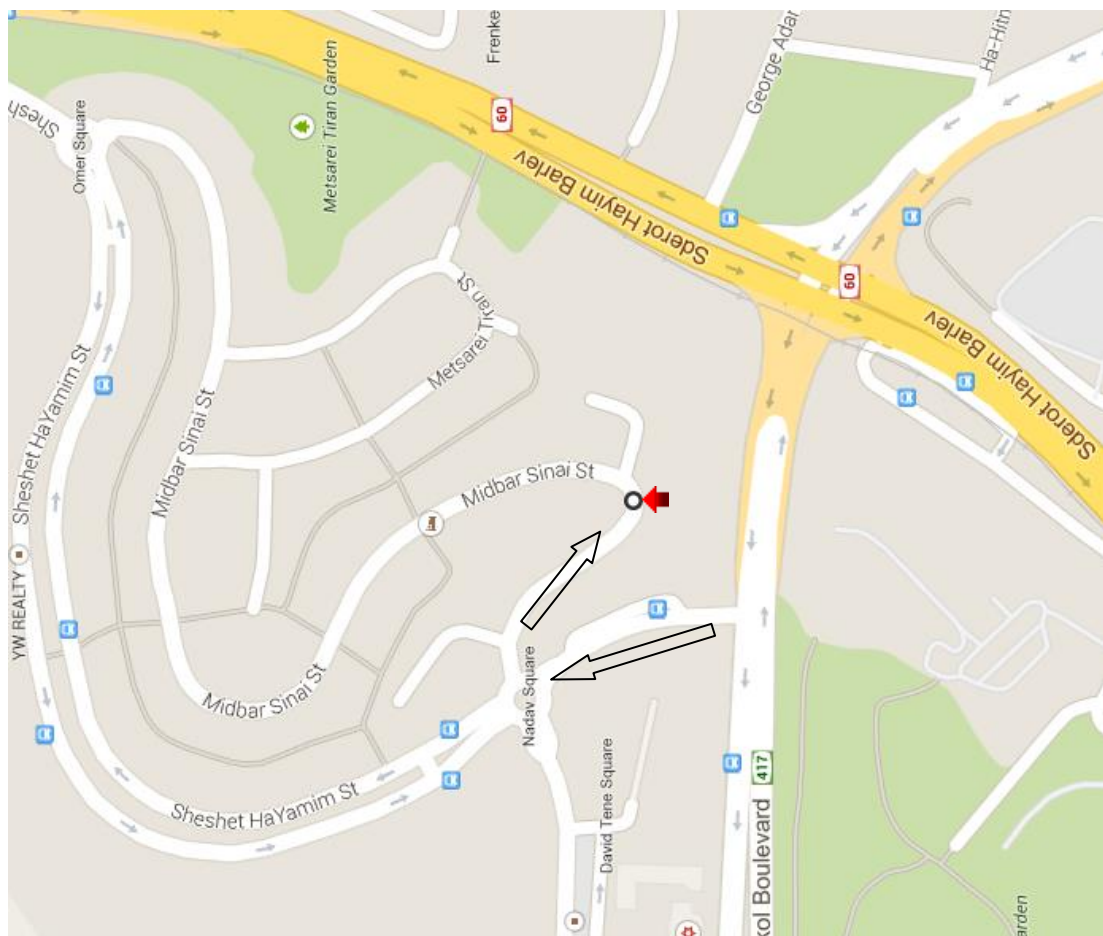
Levi Eshkol 2 entrance 3 is 300 m ahead on the right
