Description

 $2 \frac{1}{2}$ room apartment – one master bedroom, one guest bedroom, living room with a folding sofa bed and dining area. Sleeping room for 6 – maximum capacity.

The kitchen is kosher – dairy only.

Please note: DVI rents this apartment to host our volunteers from abroad and we are accountable by our landlord for any damage. DVI does not have a large maintenance staff and we therefore ask you to care for the apartment as you would your own home.

- Please do not move the furniture
- Please take care of all appliances in the apartment
- Do not leave the electric water heater on for more than 2-3 hours a day

All apartments are available from Friday at 12 noon to the following Friday until 9:30 A.M, since our cleaning lady will arrive then to clean the apartment for the next dentist. If you need to leave your luggage for a few hours, you may leave it by the door, but this must be arranged in advance with our office staff. Linens and towels are provided in the apartment, and there are basic kitchen supplies in the functional kitchen.

ON THE DAY OF YOUR DEPARTURE: We ask you to ensure the sofa bed is closed and leave everything as it was at your arrival, including clean dishes and other utensils you used during your stay. Before leaving, please make sure all windows and shades are closed. Lock the front door and take the key with you to return to your representative.

Driving directions to 1 Uziah St, Jerusalem, Israel

1. Upon leaving the airport	
2. Keep right at the fork and merge onto Route 1	42.5 km
3. Upon entering Jerusalem, the street name will	2.7 km
change to Ben Gurion St	
4. Continue on to Shazar St. (Binyanei HaUma)	850 m
5. Continue on to Ben Tzvi St.	1.2 km
6. Turn left on to Ruppin St.	230 m
7. Continue on to Ramban St.	500 m
8. Turn right onto Arlozorov St.	400 m
9. Turn left onto Ze'ev Jabotinsky St.	68 m
10. Take the first right onto David Marcus	220 km
11. At the traffic circle, take the second exit onto	300 m

12. Turn right onto Yitzchak Elchanan St.	370 m
13. Turn right onto Emek Refaim	650 m
14. Turn right onto Yonatan St.	140 m
15. Turn left onto Yehoshafat	140 m

Getting to the Clinic

On your first day of work at the clinic you will be picked up at 7:45 a.m. and taken to the clinic by a DVI staff member or volunteer. Please wait in front of the apartment building. The rest of the week, you will need to make your own way:


- 1. Turn right out of the building onto Uziyah St.
- 2. Turn right on Emek Refaim
- 3. Turn left onto General Pierre Koenig (its a major intersection)
- 4. Take your first right onto Mekor Chaim immediately after the gas station
- 5. Continue until Mekor Chaim 29 (on your left)



Directions to the DVI Clinic - Uziya

Getting to the clinic from your apartment is quite simple – it is a comfortable 10 to 15 minute walk.

- 1. Upon leaving the apartment building, turn RIGHT on Uziya St.
- 2. Follow Uziya St. to the end, where it dead-ends in to Emek Refaim St.
- 3. Turn RIGHT on Emek Refaim St.
- 4. At the traffic light, turn LEFT on to General Pierre Koenig St.
- 5. At the next traffic light, immediately after the gas/petrol station, turn RIGHT on Mekor Haim St.
- 6. The clinic is 450 meters down, on the left side Mekor Haim 29
