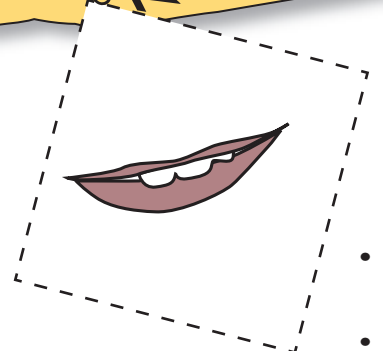

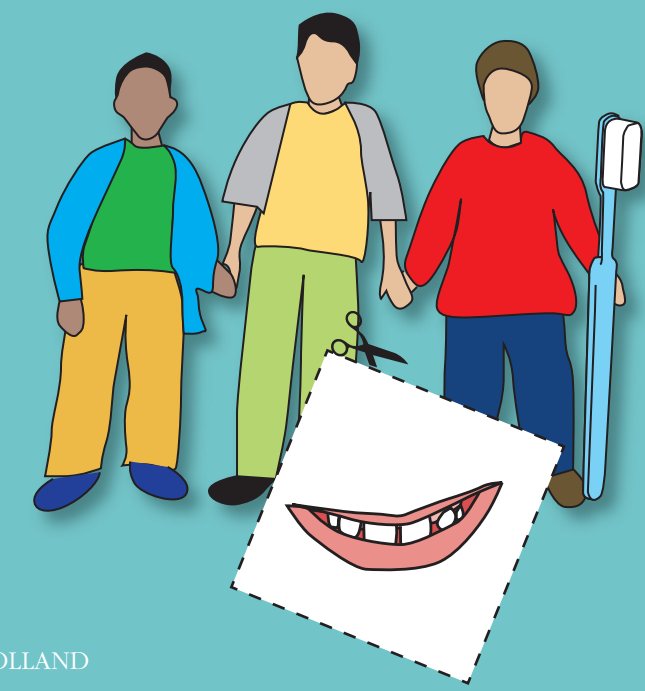
- Children, ages 5-18, who due to bad teeth have never known what it's like to smile

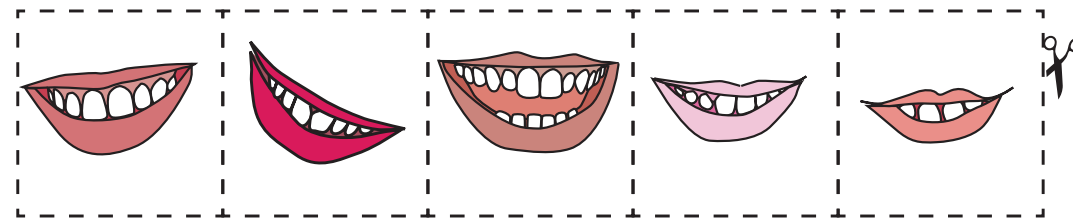
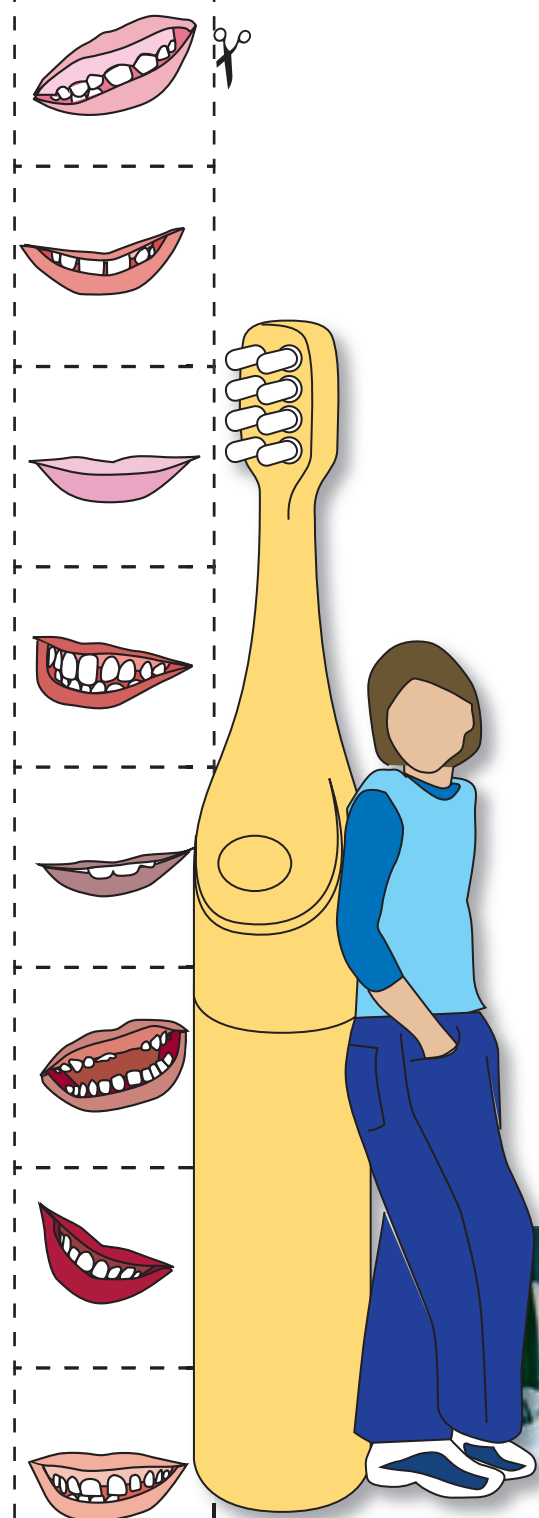

# One of a Kind DVI Clinic

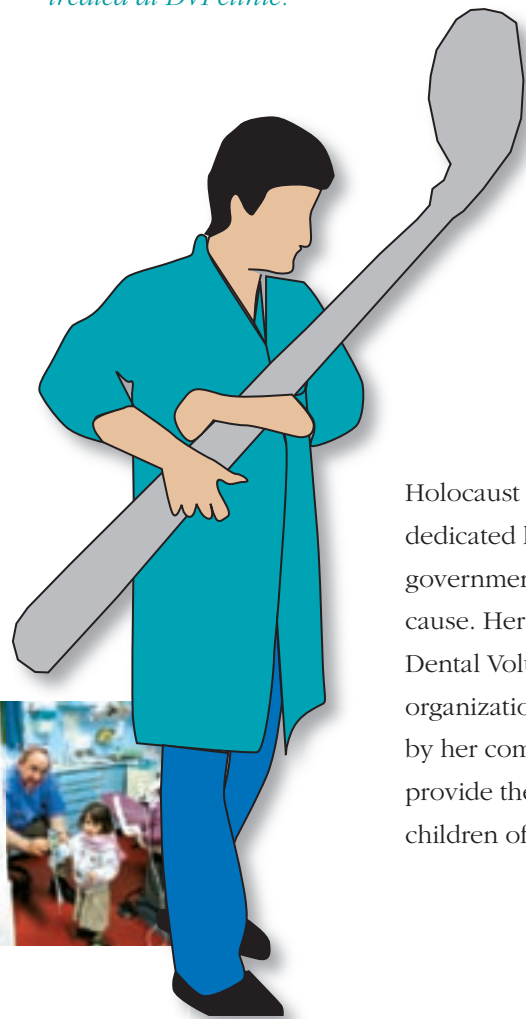
It is the only facility of its kind to offer:

- Free dental care for Jerusalem's under-privileged children
- Oral health education sessions given to every family, including comprehensive preventative dental care instruction
- Six state-of-the-art, fully equipped dental chairs
- An international staff of volunteer dentists
- A full team of dental assistants and hygienists headed by the clinic's General Director, Dr. Moti Moskovitz, DMD, Ph.D, specialist in pediatric dentistry
- DVI Clinic is a non-profit charitable organization; 95% of its budget is funded by donations of money, supplies, equipment and services
- Clinical supplies are donated by some of the largest international dental supply companies

The Trudi Birger DVI Clinic treats an average of 100 children per day.

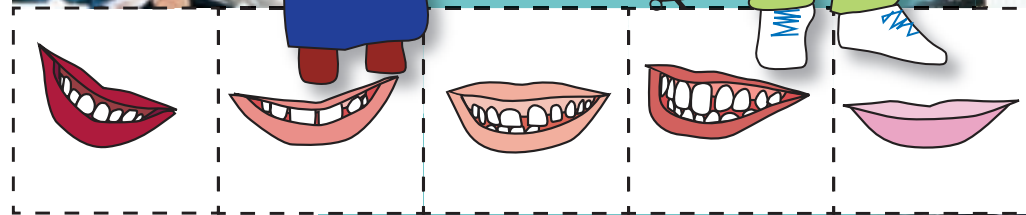
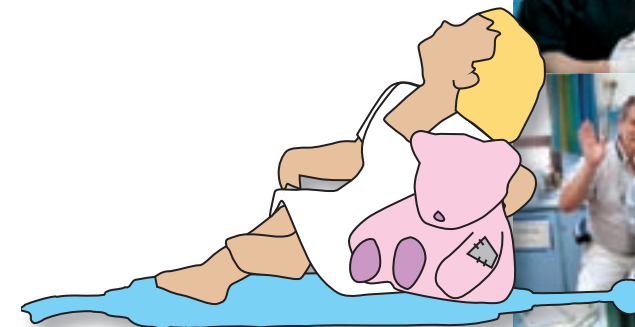
